#### The Kevin Jenkins OBE Newham Christmas Toy Appeal

The Kevin Jenkins OBE Annual Christmas Toy Appeal, the 46th Appeal of its kind, reached record numbers of children and young people this past year, providing over 2,897 with stockings of gifts in time for Christmas day. Supported once again by the Newham Recorder, the high demand for the appeal and growing numbers of requests for help reflected the challenging times and growing pressures local families are facing due to the cost-of-living crisis.

The response to our call out for support was truly incredible, with donations and toy deliveries coming in throughout December. Support was also provided by volunteers from several companies in the toy warehouse, the use of which was made possible by Gallions Reach Shopping Park this year. Along with toy donations, reflecting need, we also distributed over 100 seasonal food hampers to families in time for Christmas.

The appeal Roll of Honour, which can be found <u>here</u> highlights 60 business supporters making kind donations, along with many more individuals, churches, community groups and schools digging deep.

#### **Project Spotlight - Positive Transitions**

Our Positive Transitions project for young people aged 16 to 25 with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) focuses on supporting SEND individuals with their transition into adulthood.

Young people attending the project have the opportunity to engage in a range of activities which concentrate on building their life skills and creative skills, all of which helps to develop their confidence, self esteem, independence, social and practical skills.

The group currently meet twice a week on Wednesday and Friday mornings, with Wednesday sessions dedicated to creativity and Fridays focused on learning and developing life skills.
