

Exploring Habitats

Use magnifying Glasses and binoculars to find and investigate insects and birds, then make your own woodland map using ink, collage or paints to mark where you found them. Which will then be burnished using a selction of methods including paint with natural dyes, tea leaves, turmeric, beetroot. This will then be made into a scroll for the young people to take home.

Earth Art

Using natural materials including: recycled newspaper, leaves, grass, natural dyes, make your own shadow drawings, and create a story board of your woodland walk, tracking textures and shapes in nature.

Who Lives In The Forest?

Learn all about the different animals who call our woodland home. Explore their habitat and then make one of your own for your chosen animal, and find out more about some of our unconventional inhabitants.

Bushcraft Settlements

Use natural materials to make a shelter in teams, creating a flag that represents your team using recycled cardboard. Then take part in fun, inteactive outdoor cooking activities.
