11:50am	Tidy,pack up and goodbyes

Pioneers 10 Week Programme made up of ten 2 hour sessions (KS2&3)

Week	Activity
1	Get to know our woods, safety rules Learn how to tie knots and secure lines
2	Fire Pit - learn about fire safety, how to make your own fire using materials you find in the wood and cooking over an open fire.
3	Natures Palette - Create pieces of natural art using materials found in nature as well as incorporating materials that would otherwise be thrown away.
4	Build your own bird boxes using tools and learn about the different species that call our woods home
5	Big Build Natural Sculpture competition - create your own piece of artusing natural and recycled materials
6	Learn about the different animals that live in our woods, observe their behaviour and learn about their habitats and life cycles
7	Orienteering challenge - learn how to read a map and use a compass and navigate along the River Lea
_∞	Survival skills - learn basic survival skills including using the environment to your advantage, water resistance, basic first aid and much more
9	Group campfire putting skills learnt into practice
10	Certificate presentation, celebrating achievements and evaluation
